10.00	Today takes part in a lesson using differentiated version of new Red Rose Maths Mastery programme, delivered by class teacher. Works with a partner for a time before receiving some TA support when needed. (pupil 5 receives tutor support from catch up funding on 2 other days during the week).
11.00	Playtime - chooses to play football (supervised by a member of pastoral team)
11.15	DR - completes RWI with trained member of staff to attempt to develop reading and phonetical awareness.
12.15	Daily Mile - supervised by T and TA
12.30	Lunch provided by school. To ensure smooth transition through lunch period, pastoral members support welfare staff with supervision. Pupil 5 sits on the same table at lunch as pastoral member.
1.15pm	Watches latest Newsround and participates in class discussion about issues in the media.
1.30	Takes part in a science lesson based around changes in materials. TA supports alongside class teacher and provides focus prompts to other children not pupil A
2.30	Intervention - TA provides quick fix it time to pupils from the morning session. Pupil A receives this.
3.00	Takes mini bus home
